Consideration of Resolution 2025-1, a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors Declaring a vacancy in Seat 2 on the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Section 190.006(3)(B), Florida Statutes; providing for severability, conflicts and an effective date

Mr. Ward stated Seat 2 was up for election in 2024, no one qualified for the Seat. He explained Statute required the Board to declare a vacancy in Seat 2 and the Board would have two weeks after the date of the election to fill the Seat with a qualified elector from within the District. He asked if there were any questions.

Mr. Peter Latessa: The resolution says two members of the Board of Supervisors are to be elected, Seat 2 and 3.

Mr. Ward: Seat 3 is Carol's Seat. She was elected as part of the regular election process, that's why it says it that way. What will happen is Carol will take her seat, the new seat, two weeks after the date of the election. Normally I would swear her in, but it's too soon. I will probably do it at the next meeting, but she's already a Member of the Board as of that date.

On MOTION made by Carol Sciarrabba, seconded by Peter Latessa, and with all in favor, Resolution 2025-1 was adopted, and the Chair was authorized to sign.
