Mr. Greg Urbancic reviewed the rules relating to Lake 27. There are basically three restrictions: No docks, boat slips, moorings, pilings or other physical structures shall be placed on, in or within Lake 27 by any person or entity. Also, no boats shall be placed or operated by any person or entity within Lake 27, and there is an exclusion that nothing prevents us as the District from doing what we need to do for water management purposes to maintain that lake. Then the last one, boating, paddling, swimming, fishing, or engaging in any other recreational or entertainment activity within Lake 27 is prohibited. Those are the three prohibitions. Then it's just clean up to make it clearer.

Mr. Ward called for a motion to open the public hearing.

On MOTION made by Felipe Gonzalez, seconded by Tonya Holden, and with all in favor, the public hearing was opened.
